CROSS COUNTRY COURSE

Jumps are of a very high standard over an undulating course with a wide open track including a large water complex. EvA95 is for the more experienced prelim combination and the EvA80 is encouraging.

The new EvA65 course is a great introduction to the Wooroloo Event. It utilises the flatter areas of the grounds and is designed to give horses and riders the confidence to go on and tackle the higher grades at this venue.

WELCOME TO RIDER PARTY

A casual Welcome to Rider Gathering will be held at the grounds at 5.30pm on Friday evening.

Dress is casual and riders and their guests can purchase a Hot Beef Roll and Soup for \$15 per person. Please be early if you wish to eat. This is an opportunity for all riders to meet the Officials prior to competition. Please note, this is BYO drinks.

SATURDAY NIGHT ENTERTAINMENT

A Bonfire will be held on Saturday and Food Vans will be available to purchase food during the evening, BYO drinks.

WOOROLOO TEAMS CHALLENGE

Open to all riders from EvA65-EvA95

Please indicate by ticking the team entry box on KTrials if you wish to be included in the ballot.

Teams of 3 will be drawn, each team consisting of a rider from the 65/J65, 80/J80, 95/J95 class.

Points will be allocated to riders according to their final placing.

All rider points will be added with the highest scoring team winning.

Rugs and rosettes will be presented to the winning team.

Please note: not all nominated riders will be drawn on a team. The number of team places available will be calculated on the lowest number of nominated riders in any particular class.

Riders nominating multiple horses will not be permitted to be drawn twice unless numbers permit. This is to give everyone the best chance of being drawn onto a team.

HELPERS/VOLUNTEERS

It is a condition of entry that all riders provide a Helper/Volunteer over the age of 16 years.

Job preferences as submitted on online entry will be considered but not guaranteed.

All helper duties will be approximately 3 to 4 hours and may take place while your child/partner etc is riding. The helper for a rider competing with more than one horse will be required to complete an extended session of help.

Volunteers are such an important part of any event and cannot possibly run efficiently without your help.

SELF HELP

- Self help is limited and will be **ONLY** be by prior arrangement with the Event Secretary.
- Self help is not available to riders of more than one horse unless completed prior to the event.
- Self helpers who have not selected busy bee will be allocated canteen or XC Jump Judge and will either be one 3-4 hour shift or 2 shorter shifts.
- Paid help is not self help.

PAID HELPER DUTIES

Riders intending to use paid help must do so through the WA Helper Duty Database. Please contact Kirsten Twining - wahdd@yahoo.com Use the code **DB** in front of the helpers name and nominate **XCJJ** as the helper duty.

BUSY BEE

Busy Bee participation is in lieu of helper duty. Those intending to provide self help are recommended to attend the busy bee to complete their duty.

The Busy Bee will be held 11th & 12th August however there are limited tasks that can be allocated to helpers the week preceding the event on request to the event secretary.

WITHDRAWALS

Via Ktrials until close of entries. Withdrawals prior to the Event closing on KTrials will receive a full refund less an admin fee.

After close of entries, the secretary must be notified of withdrawals via email: pht@hotmail.com.au It is requested that you do so as soon as possible.

REFUNDS

Full refund on withdrawal of entry before closing date (less 10% online admin fee).

Refund of entries after closing date, will consist of **EA Levy, Ground Fee and the EADCMP fee (where applicable).**

A proportion of fees MAY be refunded at the Committee's discretion if:

- Helper duty is completed
- Circumstances are considered by the Organising Committee as fair and reasonable

A Technical Delegate will be available at 4.30pm Saturday afternoon to give approval for Camera's to be worn.

NOTE: Only video nominees sanctioned by the Technical Delegate will be used for video review!

ICE

Will be on sale at the grounds at 8.00am until 8.30am on Sunday morning of the XC on the south side of the showjumping arena near the toilet block (Committee carpark). Cost will be \$5.00 per bag. Please bring the correct change. Otherwise available from the Wooroloo Store or Chidlow Growers Market.

REFRESHMENTS

A variety of refreshment options will be available over the weekend and will include the Pink Moo Coffee Van, food vans and the canteen will be operating during the day on Friday, Saturday, Sunday and limited on Monday. The Canteen will provide breakfast on all days.

MEDICAL ARMBANDS

Whilst it is not required to wear an armband during Cross Country, if you do have a medical condition or have recently had a head injury, it is necessary for you to wear a medical armband. A form is available from the Office which should also be filled out and will be handed to the Paramedics for their information. This is your responsibility and is important.

PARKING

Due to FEI regulations, classes will have designated parking areas.

Parking instructions must be adhered to or you will be asked to relocate.
